ROBERT PARKER

Their 2016 Brunello di Montalcino Corte Pavone shows a touch of natural rubber that appears before the Sangiovese **fruit and the spice expected** of a wine released five years after the harvest. Once the wine has had ample **time to open**, **the fruit, spice and balsam tones come into greater focus**. I'd suggest this 13,700-bottle release for near or medium-term drinking.



JAMES SUCKLING

Pleasant aromas of mixed **berries with flowers, lemon grass** and a hint of charcuterie. Full-to medium-bodied with intense flavors of **blackberries and minerals**, reined in by tightly packed, fine tannins and gradually winding down to a **long, savory finish** for now. From organically grown grapes. Still very young with lots of energy. Give it a couple of years. Try from 2023.



JANCIS ROBINSON

Lustrous deep ruby. **Tight nose of minerally, perfumed cherry fruit** with a hint of tar. **Lots of juice** and energetic tangy fruit lined with chewy tannins. More open on the palate than the nose. Elegant. (WS)

ROBERT PARKER

The Loacker 2016 Brunello di Montalcino Corte Pavone Fiore del Vento is characterized by a **soothing sense of consistency and balance**. There is **tranquility in this fruit**, with no hard edges, which suggests easy and trouble-free winemaking. The wine boasts a darkly saturated color with blackberry fruit, cherry, spice and lots of Zen. You'll appreciate the **balance** in the Fiore del Vento, **as well as the power and the quality** of the fruit. It ages in a combination of tonneau and cement. Great job, but too bad only 2,400 bottles were made.



JAMES SUCKLING

Enticing nose with aromas of **red berries, hazelnuts** and some tamarind-like, spicy character. Full to medium palate with **intense, spicy fruit flavors that ride the fine tannins** through to a long, **energetic finish**. From organically grown grapes. Drinkable now for its energy, but hold until 2023 to get a more mellow expression.

ROBERT PARKER

The Loacker 2016 Brunello di Montalcino Corte Pavone Fior di Meliloto is an angular and etched wine (from sand, limestone and schistous galestro terrain) with the tannic definition and the acidity to maintain a **rigid and upright personality**. These are some of the qualities you look for in a **cellar-worthy vintage** such as 2016. With only 2,000 bottles made, Fior di Meliloto is one of three new single-vineyard Brunellos on offer from this estate, and the character of this wine is tight, nervous and needy of more **time to evolve and soften**. I have moved the drinking window up accordingly.



JAMES SUCKLING

Blackberry, black-cherry, herb and crushed-stone character to this full-bodied, **round and silky Brunello with lots of juicy fruit pushing through the finish**. From organically grown grapes. Turns firm on the finish, indicating that **this has some way to go**. But the juicy fruit makes it delicious even now. Best from 2023.

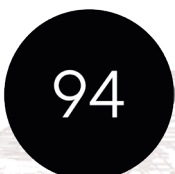

ROBERT PARKER

With vineyards beyond a long cypress-lined drive, the Loacker 2016 Brunello di Montalcino Corte Pavone Campo Marzio **offers dark fruit layers and richness**. This wine draws its fruit from the estate's oldest vines planted in clayey soils. This Sangiovese reveals dried blackberry and raspberry with soft cherry and spice. It shows a lot of **natural concentration** enhanced by leather, balsam herb, tar and licorice. The Campo Marzio, named after the area of ancient Rome that was used for military training and is today home to the most picturesque parts of the Centro Storico including the Pantheon, is **a robust and muscular wine with the structure to carry it over the next 10 years**.

This 2,900-bottle release is made with biodynamic and organic fruit.

Aromas of ripe raspberries and ash with some dog-rose petals. Medium-bodied with **very fine tannins and plenty of intense, almost tangy fruit and mineral flavor**. A little lean at the end for now. Give this a couple of years to fill out.

From organically grown grapes. Try from 2023.

JAMES SUCKLING

Lovely aromas of crushed blackberries, mushrooms, wet stones and cardamom. A light, gamey note, too. Full-to medium-bodied with intense, juicy fruit flavors that vie with still firm, fine tannins. The finish is long, intense and savory, leaving a salty aftertaste. From organically grown grapes. Interesting to taste now, but better to drink after 2022.



ROBERT PARKER

Showing a bright and buoyant quality of fruit, the 2015 Brunello di Montalcino Riserva Corte Pavone Vigna Poggio Molino al Vento accomplishes two important things. First, it delivers on the promise of richness, softness and concentration of the 2015 vintage. Second, it does so without feeling too heavy or extracted. This is a powerful, full-bodied wine for sure, but ultimately it shows balance. Compared to Loacker's other Riserva, the Anemone al Sole, this wine offers a degree more intensity, more ripeness for sure, and more pronounced tannins. This is the bigger, more structured and ultimately more cellar-worthy of the two. The wine's name Molino al Vento (windmill) pays homage to the winds that blow over this highest altitude vineyard.

Anemone al Sole

The Loacker 2016 Brunello di Montalcino Riserva Corte Pavone Anemone al Sole (an organic and biodynamic wine) is **redolent of dark fruit and spice**, although some aged aromas of licorice and cola are also slipped in for greater effect and power. The wine is tarry and smoky for sure. At the end of the day, this wine is a little too defined by the oak and alcohol at this stage, but it should hopefully **soften with time in the bottle**.

Kraftvolles, dichtes Rubin. **Intensive Nase** mit Noten nach eingelegten Kirschen und Zwetschken, etwas Waldhimbeere, **feine Würze**. **Rund und geschmeidig** im Ansatz, öffnet sich mit griffigem, herzhaftem Tannin, **tiefgründig, satte Frucht**, gepaart mit einem Hauch Bitterschokolade im Finale.



JAMES SUCKLING

Very rich fruit character to this with lots of crushed black fruit, together with hints of dark chocolate and peppery notes. **Full-bodied with fine and firm tannins**, coated with lots of flavor. Bitter-chocolate finish. From organically grown grapes. Not overly complex, but well structured and delicious. Drinkable now, but better from 2023.
